Enter the website. Go to <https://www.extendago.com/sign-up-extendago/> for registration. Enter required information.








1. Enter required information: Shop name and Woocommerce URL e.g. <https://yourdomain.com>





- Choose date (only download orders from)

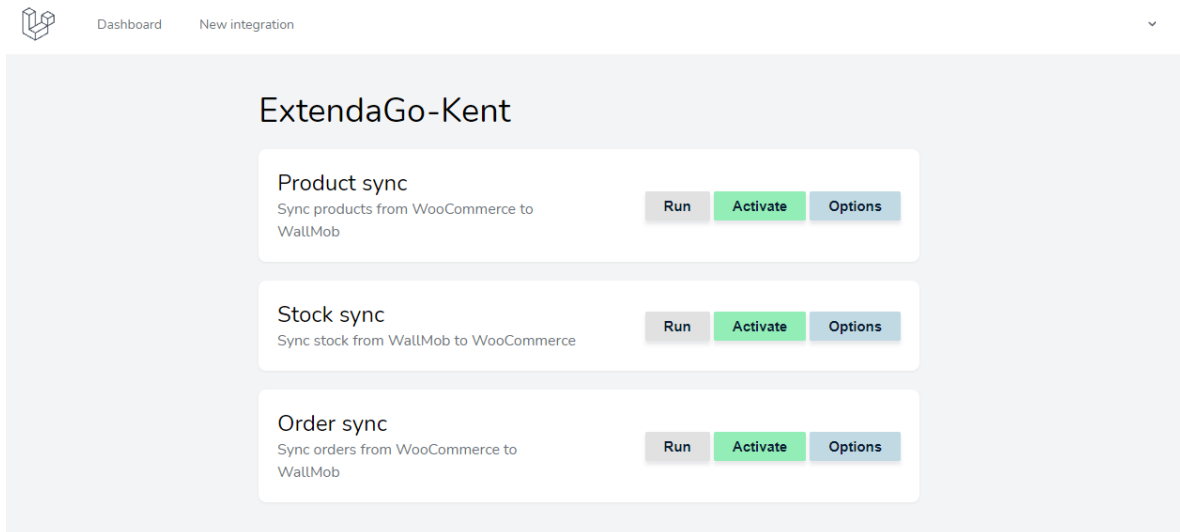

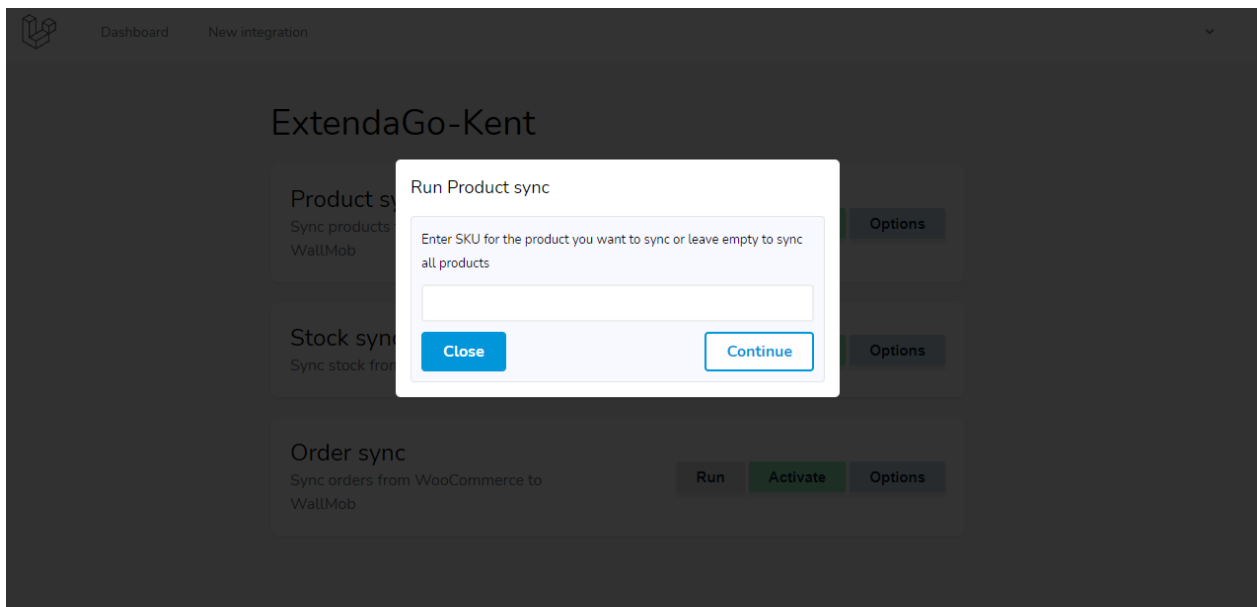

Push the "Run" button to sync products, stock and orders.




When you press the "Run" button you get the option to define the SKU you want to sync. Leave empty for all products, stock or orders.


Set Sync to be Activate or Deactivate.
